



Randi's search for a living kidney donor... Please consider a Gift of Life.

Dear Friends & Family,

Some of you may know that I have kidney disease. I am a 76 year old from Parsonsfield, and over time, my kidney disease has gotten worse, causing my kidneys not to work well enough to keep me alive. My treatment options at this time are limited to dialysis or a kidney transplant. I have been on dialysis for some time now, 3 days a week for 4 hours each day, which is helping my kidneys do their job of removing wastes, toxins, and extra fluids. But the longer you are on dialysis the more your health deteriorates.

However, a living donor kidney transplant would offer me much more freedom and the ability to live a longer, healthier, and more meaningful life. A transplant would also give me more time to do the things I love most, such as spending time with my family and friends, my partner Nick, my pets, helping others, and being outdoors.

Finding a kidney is not easy. People who are on a wait list for a kidney from a deceased donor often have to wait 5-10 years and the kidney lasts on average 10-20 years. But the wait list for a living kidney donor is much shorter, sometimes even months, and the kidney typically lasts 20-30 years. It also has much better function.

In order to donate, living kidney donors get a careful and thorough evaluation with your own team of health professionals to see if you could be a match for me and to ensure that living donation is as safe as possible for you.

I want to share with you some basic information about kidney donation.

- 1) You only need one kidney to live a long, healthy life.
- 2) The surgery for a donor is done laparoscopically, meaning through tiny incisions, and the recuperation period is fairly quick, generally only a few weeks.
- 3) The cost of an evaluation and surgery would be covered by my insurance, and there are programs like Donor Shield that can help with other charges.
- 4) Although my blood type is O+, you do not necessarily have to have the same blood or tissue type to be a match.
- 5) There is no age limit to be a donor. You just have to have a healthy kidney.

There are also other websites that can help you learn about kidney disease and donation.

PARSONSFIELD- Peter F. Nielsen, 77, passed away at his beloved home in Parsonsfield on December 19, 2025, surrounded by his loving family. Peter was born in Portland, Maine, son of Christian and Arlene. He graduated from Deering High School in 1967. After graduation, Peter enlisted in the Marine Corps (1968-1972) and bravely served his country in the Vietnam War from 1969-1970 in the 2nd Marine Division 5th Battalion. His service also included a tour in Okinawa, Japan, from 1971-1972. Peter always reflected fondly on his time in Japan. He made friends and even taught the local children how to play baseball. They affectionately called him "Peter San."

After his military service, Peter spent time in Long Island, New York. He moved back to Maine and married the love of his life, Nancy Lankau, on September 7, 1974, at Aimhi Lodge on Little Sebago Lake. In 1975, they settled in Parsonsfield, which became Peter's favorite place on Earth. It was there Peter and Nancy raised their four beautiful children. Peter enjoyed the simple things in life, such as raising cows, pigs, turkeys, and chickens; making homemade maple syrup; tending an apple orchard; making cider with an antique apple cider press; haying local fields; spending time in his barn; deer hunting; making birdhouses; and above all else, spending time with his family and friends.





Being a "true farmer at heart", Jerry's life passion was haying, riding his beloved John Deere Tractors around the town of Limerick and caring for his cattle.



All Baldwin full and part-time employees who meet the requirements of Maine Title 26, Chapter 7, Subchapter 6-C are covered by Maine's Paid Family and Medical Leave Act. The Town of Baldwin pays 100% of the program cost." The cost is 1% of the employees' wages and is covered by the funding approved in the budget at the FY26 Town Meeting.

The Select Board Recommends approval of this article

ARTICLE 3. To see what sum the Town shall approve in additional FY26 funds to cover the cost, one additional health insurance policy in 2025 and two additional policies starting 1 January 2026? This covers policies that were not included in the FY26 Town budget request and is to be funded from the undesignated fund balance at the current 80% Town funding rate.

The Select Board Recommends approval of \$19,687.56

ARTICLE 4. Shall an amendment to Municipal Employees Personnel Ordinance be enacted to increase the Town's contribution for eligible employee health insurance from 80% to 100% as follows:

Page 15 number 34.B. at the top of the page Delete "The Town (employer) pays 80% of the cost of the premium for the single employee. The employee is responsible for the remainder of the cost." And replace it with "The Town (employer) pays 100% of the cost of the premium for the single employee."
