Randi's search for a living kidney donor...

Please consider a Gift of Life.

Dear Friends & Family,

Some of you may know that I have kidney disease. I am a 76 year old from Parsonsfield, and over time, my kidney disease has gotten worse, causing my kidneys not to work well enough to keep me alive. My treatment options at this time are limited to dialysis or a kidney transplant. I have been on dialysis for some time now, 3 days a week for 4 hours each day, which is helping my kidneys do their job of removing wastes, toxins, and extra fluids. But the longer you are on dialysis the more your health deteriorates.

However, a living donor kidney transplant would offer me much more freedom and the ability to live a longer, healthier, and more meaningful life. A transplant would also give me more time to do the things I love most, such as spending time with my family and friends, my partner Nick, my pets, helping others, and being outdoors.

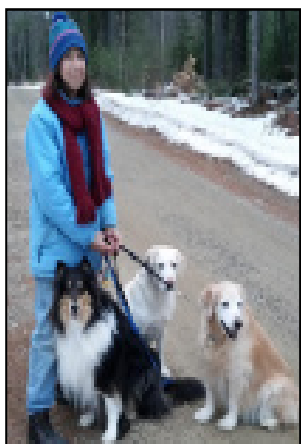
Finding a kidney is not easy. People who are on a wait list for a kidney from a deceased donor often have to wait 5-10 years and the kidney lasts on average 10-20 years. But the wait list for a living kidney donor is much shorter, sometimes even months, and the kidney typically lasts 20-30 years. It also has much better function.

In order to donate, living kidney donors get a careful and thorough evaluation with your own team of health professionals to see if you could be a match for me and to ensure that living donation is as safe as possible for you.

I want to share with you some basic information about kidney donation.

- 1) You only need one kidney to live a long, healthy life.
- 2) The surgery for a donor is done laparoscopically, meaning through tiny incisions, and the recuperation period is fairly quick, generally only a few of weeks.
- 3) The cost of an evaluation and surgery would be covered by my insurance, and there are programs like Donor Shield that can help with other charges.
- 4) Although my blood type is O+, you do not necessarily have to have the same blood or tissue type to be a match.
- 5) There is no age limit to be a donor. You just have to have a healthy kidney.

BROWNFIELD – Robert Calnan, 82, passed away peacefully at his home on April 11, 2026, surrounded by his family.

After graduating from Porter High School, he served as a Sergeant in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War. BROWNFIELD RESIDENTS

We all love the new playground,
 but again we were sold something without all the facts.

We spent \$170,000 on a new playground. What if I told you we could have had \$340,000 playground and all of Dunn Memorial Park remodeled?

On March 17th Chairman Emery mentioned a letter from Maine Bureau of Parks and Land. According to Mr. Emery we opted out of the grant program and are no longer required to participate in the grant we received in 1987 for the playground.

In speaking with Catherine Default of State of Maine parks and land we are forever required to maintain the park. The state would have paid 50% of the new playground. Yes, we would have had to apply for a new grant. The town was told in April of last year to get their application by June and the money would be available this summer.

As it stands right now, we are obligated to maintain Dunn Memorial and are required to put something of equal value back in its place, The original grant was \$80,000.

Why were we not told this? Shouldn't this have been a taxpayer's decision? There were other places on Dunn Memorial the playground could have gone. What was the rush? All of this information was available at town meeting last year. Again, why was it not given to taxpayers and now we have to cough up another 80,000. As of now the town hasn't even contacted the state, we are ignoring them.

There is way more than meets the eye with the community center. We spent \$58,000 on a new boiler yet they want to put heat pumps in, a survey was recently done for Dunn Memorial Park, a new playground, a fire suppression system, and a grant for a new generator is in the works. Exterior work is being done on the building. Yet no one says anything about the amount of asbestos in the building. We need to halt any additional work on the community center until we as a town can decide what our vision is going forward.

Something that's been lost along the way is,
