





### Carroll Wayne Hansen

PARSONSFIELD - Carroll Wayne Hansen, age 96,

passed away peacefully surrounded by family on Friday, May 3rd, 2024 at Maine Medical Center. Wayne was born November 28, 1927, to Beatrice (Bickford) and Otto C. Hansen, and in his own words, he "entered the atmosphere in a front bedroom of the house across the street from the East Parsonsfield Post Office. Three



years later brother, Clyde popped out at the same loca-

Wayne attended schools in Parsonsfield and graduated from Par-Sem. During his junior year of high school, he joined the Maine State Guard in Kezar Falls. He later enlisted in the Army Air Corp, followed by the Air Force as a Power Turret & Gunsight Repairman and a member of the 39th Air Engineering Squadron, where he primarily worked on B-29s. He was decorated with a World War II Victory Medal. He received an honorable discharge from the military in April of 1948 after an injury requiring surgery. He returned to Maine and worked for the Dairy Herd Improvement Association, and later attended Northeastern School for Accounting. After one year he couldn't see himself working in an office, so he started driving trucks for an apple company. During this time he was photographed and featured in Ford Times magazine, published by Ford Motor Company, driving a brand-new Ford truck. He was very proud of this. He worked for General Electric in Limerick for several years. Then he bought his first dump truck in 1959 and a second in 1961, which he used building roads for local towns. In 1968 he sold the trucks and began a career as a rural letter carrier for the Post Office, where he worked until his retirement in 1993.

Wayne was a member of the Rural Letter Carriers' Association, the American Legion, Disabled American Veterans, and the Air Force Association. Formerly a Parsonsfield Road Commissioner and a Trustee of Parsonsfield Seminary, he was also a former member of the Parsonsfield Planning Board, the Parsonsfield Budget Committee, the Friends of Par-Sem, Kiwanis, and various ATV Clubs.

Wayne enjoyed many pastimes over the years. Some of his favorites were hunting, fishing, golfing, bowling, ATVing, caring for his horses, (Sherry and Gabe), oil painting, and of course writing poetry as the self-proclaimed Parsonsfield poet. You could often find him jerry-rigging anything and everything with duct tape. He loved spending time with family and traveling.

Wayne was predeceased by his first wife, Nona E. (Ayer) Hansen in 1999; and his younger brother, Clyde


There have been many repairs made over the years. In 2019 we had a complete evaluation done by an engineer and received a 37 page report explaining what needs to be done, a complete restoration.


We know this will not be easy.
