CORNISH - Darin Kelsey Manchester, age 62, passed away peacefully at his home on January 31, 2026, following a battle with dementia & ALS.



Darin was born on November 28, 1963, at Westbrook Hospital, the first-born son of Patricia Phinney and Laforest "Joe" Manchester. Following the death of his father, his mother later remarried Teddy Dyer, and the family moved to Cornish, a town that Darin loved and where he stayed to raise his family.

He attended Cornish Elementary and later graduated from Sacopee Valley High School. After high school, Darin proudly served in the Army National Guard.

Darin built his career as a skilled carpenter, taking great pride in his work as a finish carpenter before becoming a custom cabinet maker admired for his craftsmanship. He worked for Trico Millwork in Limington, where his craftsmanship, attention to detail, and strong work ethic were well known and respected. He left Trico in 2018 due to a disability.

To say Darin loved hunting and fishing would be an understatement. He was famously "infected with buck fever" every October through December and never missed a hunting season—until this past year. He loved spending time outdoors gardening, sitting by a campfire and never passed up a party with family and friends. OBITUARY

Ernest A. Perreault, Sr.

BROWNFIELD - It is with great sadness that we share the passing of our father, Ernest A. Perreault, Sr., 89, on February 5, 2026, with his family by his side. He was born September 21, 1936, to the late Ernest J. and Blanche L. (Charest) Perreault in Somersworth, NH. The family moved to Brownfield when he was a young boy, and he put down deep roots.

Ernest attended local elementary schools and graduated from Fryeburg Academy in 1955.

In 1958, Ernest married Charlotte Huntress, and together they built a wonderful life, partners in everything they did for 56 years. They gardened, farmed, raised livestock, and three sons. Hunting, fishing, camping, and snowmobiling added fun. Family was the cornerstone of their lives, and the circles of family and friends expanded exponentially over the years. They continued the tradition of family Sunday dinners, hosting them weekly. All were welcomed with open arms; they'd add more tables and chairs, and the food never ran out.

In his early years, Ernest sold slab wood and worked on several poultry farms. He shifted gears and worked in auto mechanics and body work at Holden Bros. Ford and Walker's Chevrolet. He and Charlotte then opened Perreault's Market in Brownfield. Although he enjoyed the people, Ernest was drawn back to cars. In the late 1960's, he opened his own business, Perreault's Garage, which he operated until he retired due to health reasons. His enjoyment of cars included owning a 1929 and a 1930 Ford Model A. He drove them to car shows and in parades and was a member of the Maine Obsolete Auto League (MOAL). He was a collector of car and truck figures and showcased them in hand-crafted displays.

Ernest gave back to his community by being involved. He was a selectman for the Town of Brownfield for ten years, a member of the Brownfield Volunteer Fire Co., and on the board of directors of the Burnt Meadow Mountain Ski Area.

For 55 years, Ernest was a Mason with the Mt. Moriah Lodge, missing only three meetings in all those years. He embodied the principles of Freemasonry: integrity, friendship, respect, and service. He also joined the Order of the Eastern Star.

Ernest was a founding member of the Burnt Meadow Snowmobile Club. He organized countless family & club rides ('burning a dog on the trail'), attended rallies, and manned the fundraising booth at the Fryeburg Fair. He was the club trailmaster for twenty-five years and groomed local trails until last year.



Ernest was a member of the Brownfield Historical Society, sharing his extensive knowledge of local history. He was a major contributor to the recent restoration of the Christ Church in Brownfield, sharing his problem-solving and carpentry skills. He delighted in hearing the bell ring anew.

Aside from the things he did, Ernest was most known for his passion for life; the twinkle in his eye, a mischievous smile, and a ready laugh.

There was always a story to tell and strangers to befriend. He tackled everything with enthusiasm. If something wasn't working...he figured it out, or figured out his own way to make it work. He crafted solutions and fabricated fixes. He taught his boys how to work hard and be good men. He shared his skills, time, and camaraderie. He loved to feed people's bellies and spirits. And he played a fierce, strategic game of cards. He lived with moxie.

Ernest was lucky to experience love a second time when he met Nancy Boucher at the historical society. Their adventurous day trips ranged from the top of Mount Washington to the coast of Maine, as they strolled through antique markets and dined on seafood. They cheered on the Red Sox and the Patriots. She cared for him in the late stages of his illness, making it possible for him to be home, as he wished. His family is very grateful for her steadfast attentiveness.

Ernest was predeceased by his parents; wife Charlotte; son Ronald; brothers George and Emile Perreault; sister Teresa Day; sisters-in-law Shirley Taylor and Gloria Perreault; and brothers-in-law Ray Leavitt Sr., Donald Day, and Paul Martin.

He is survived by his sons Ernest Jr. (and April), and Richard (and Cristin); sisters Alice Leavitt, Doris (and Keith) Burnell, and Ida Martin; in-laws Paul Taylor, Ray and Louise Huntress, and Verona and Glenn Blake; grandchildren: Tim, Rick, Courtney, Bobbi Jean, Nathan, and Andrew; many great-grandchildren, nieces and nephews, and extended family

GeneAnn (Linscott) Mayo

LIMINGTON - GeneAnn (Linscott) Mayo went to be with our Lord and Savior on February 7, 2026 at the ripe old age of 103 after a long and fruitful life well lived.

She was born October 17, 1922, in Kezar Falls (Parsonsfeld), Maine. The second daughter of Leroy Linscott and Marion Leone (Davis) Linscott. When GeneAnn was born, indoor plumbing and electricity were creature comforts reserved for the urban areas. She would be a young mother of three before power was common in the rural areas of our state.

At 10 years old, when her father purchased the old McKenny farm just across the Limington town line, she walked to what was known as the "Bean School" in District 9 about half a mile from the farm. At that time in history, Limington had (12) one room primary schools with children attended through 8th grade. As a young girl, she walked over 5 miles, uphill both ways (literally), making the trek from the farm on Rt. 25 to Limington Academy at Limington Village (for her first two years of secondary education). She finished her education at Deering High School in Portland with the class of 1940, earning her room and board while attending school by taking care of an elderly lady, Laura Palmer, that she resided with during this time.

She started working as a young girl at just 12 years old, first being employed as a maid and housekeeper by Racine "Geet" Tucker, spending the summer of 1934 at the old Tucker Farm on Tucker Road in Limington where she made \$4 per week for her efforts.

She maintained her strong work ethic throughout her life, going on to run Beehive Ceramics for over 30 years. She won many blue ribbons at local fairs for her artistic abilities and intricate painted ceramics. She taught ceramics to the public in her shop even after she stopped producing ceramics commercially, continuing this until she was 80.

She married Herbert Kimball Mayo, on 21 July 1941. She met Herb while attending Deering High School in her Junior year, and they dated through the rest of her secondary years, before graduating in 1940. Their lasting love spanned over 6 decades until his death in 2001, living and raising a family together in the same house where she lived until nearly the day she passed away.

She had a passionate love of Music, and self taught herself piano and guitar (Dobro), and was also a good singer and yodeler. She played with a local group that met in her home or other locations around town, playing old time country and even recording a CD of their music that they played together.

She was active in Eastern Star and a Past District Deputy Grand Matron as well as a Life Member of Adnah Chapter.



She was a member of the Daughters of the Nile with Kora Shrine. Additional civic associations included being a life member of Limington Grange (later Acton Grange), and the Order of the Pythian Sisters-Narraganset Temple (Buxton) until their closing. She was an active member of the South Limington Free Baptist Church, being lovingly referred to as the "Pie Lady" for many years as she provided many pies for the public suppers which she assisted putting on.

She had a great love of gardening, having kept her backyard full of vegetables for many years and her front yard full of all types of flowers. She loved to watch the birds feed on her back porch and also fed the squirrels, even though they could become a nuisance and scare off the birds.

She is pre-deceased by her loving husband of over 60 years, Herbert Kimball Mayo, her daughter Natalie Faye Marshall, son Phillip Leroy Mayo Sr, daughter in law Catherine Marion (Candage) Mayo, granddaughter Laurie Jean Marshall, and grandson Michael David Mayo Jr., her parents Leroy and Marion, and all of her brothers and sisters, Richard Linscott, Marion Elizabeth "Betty" Gammon, Robert Linscott, Cleo Garland, and Donald "Bucky" Linscott.

She is survived by her son Michael David Mayo Sr., grandchildren Wanda Lynn Emery (Larry) of Buxton ME, Herbert James Marshall (Summer) of Hiram ME, Robert Clay Marshall (Melissa) of Buxton ME, Phillip Leroy Mayo, Jr. of Tifton GA, Robert Kimball Mayo (Laura) of Bryans Road MD, Diane Margaret McCubrey (David) of Cornish, ME, Crystal Lynn Adams (Jeff) of Lebanon, ME, Bryan Keith Mayo of Sanford, ME, and Jonathan Kimball Mayo (Heather) of Limington, ME, 18 Great-Grandchildren, 18 Great-Great-Grandchildren, and 1 Great-Great-Great-Grandchild, numerous nieces, nephews and loving family friends who will all dearly miss her presence in their lives. 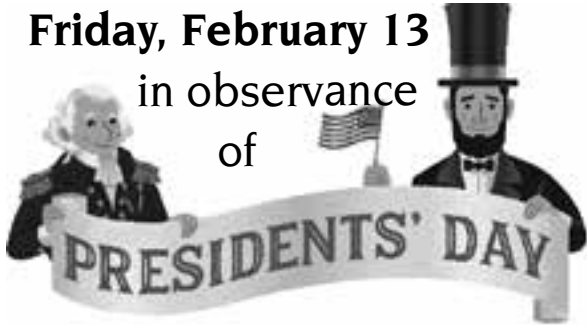

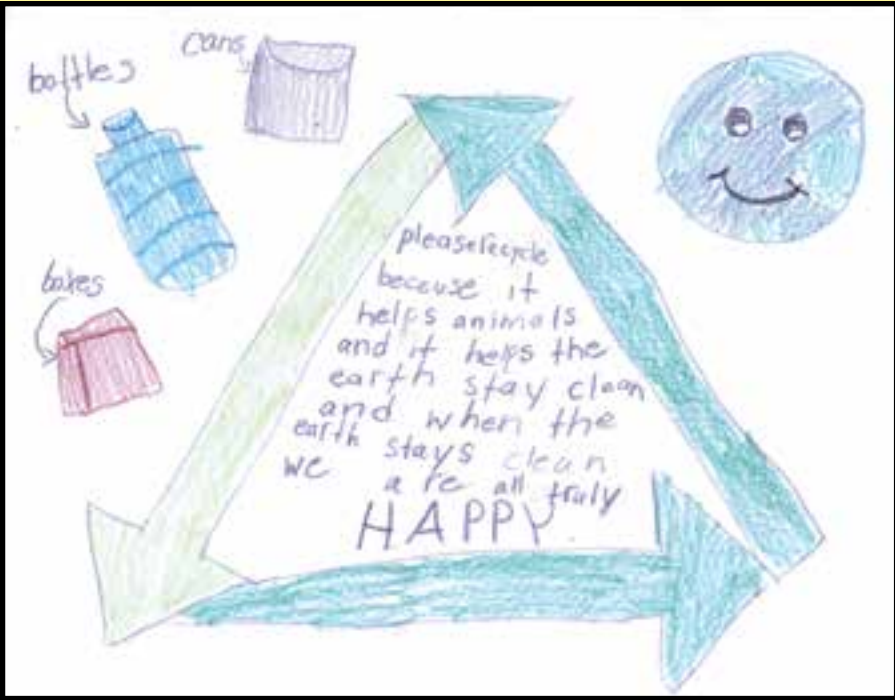
