



Robert Puncheon

JOHNSON CITY, NEW YORK - Longtime Cornish resident Robert Puncheon, 79, died April 2, 2024 from complications of kidney failure. Puncheon had moved to Johnson City with his spouse, Gary Hamelin, in 2017 after residing on High Road in Cornish for 31 years.

Known for his sophisticated enthusiasm for music, food and films, Rob will long be remembered for his hearty laugh, acerbic wit and kind heart. His enthusiasm for films enabled him to speak about the finer points of work by Bergman or Hitchcock as well as recite ribald lines from comedies such as "Airplane!." He was an avid reader who enjoyed a range of fiction including Lawrence Durrell's "Alexandria Quartet" and Stephen King's works. He also enjoyed swapping books with friends.

Rob was born October 20, 1944, in Philadelphia. He grew up in Brilliant, Ohio, and Pittsburgh before earning a bachelor's degree in English and then a master's degree in music history from Miami University of Ohio. After college, he taught high school English at The University School in Pittsburgh, and at Walpole High School while furthering his music studies in the Boston area. While music remained a centerpiece of his life, Rob took on a culinary career when he moved to New England, both catering events and baking pastries that were sold in restaurants in Boston and

Rob and Gary met in 1978, beginning a 45-year relationship that eventually brought them north to Cornish. In 1986, they bought what had been the Tanguay Farm on High Road, and together, filled the 1860s-era farmhouse with antiques, music and gourmet cuisine while entertaining friends from away and making new ones in the community.

The couple's love of cooking was evident in the farmhouse kitchen where pots and pans hung unless they were on the stove-and something was always on the stove. Their love of opera, especially works by Verdi or Puccini, was evident on summer evenings as the arias from sopranos wafted through the breezes and up the hill.

Tragically, the house burned down in December 2000, but Kob and Gary rebuilt on the same spot that captures westward views into the White Mountains.

While living in Cornish, Rob continued to cater and bake, including wedding cakes for friends. He also tended bar on occasions at the Cornish Inn and Thompson Park Grille. A vivid storyteller, Rob also loved reminiscing about restaurants in Boston's North End and the characters that owned and frequented

The couple eventually moved to upstate New York to be closer to family and healthcare services as Rob's health complications grew.




Dear Community,
