

After graduating from SVHS, Isaiah Fields went to college and graduated from Hofstra Law School. He is currently the Chief Legal Officer at Axon Enterprise. Isaiah expressed that MSAD 55 gave him the tools to be successful in life, and that he would like to give back to help the next generation have more opportunities for success. Recently, our Sacopee Valley High National Honor Society and Sacopee Valley High Student Council interviewed Mr. Fields. Lily Kick - Can you describe your experiences after leaving SVHS?



I graduated SVHS in 1995 and went to Hofstra for an undergraduate degree and then straight to Hofstra Law School. My father died my second year of law school, so I took a one year leave of absence and lived in Cornish and worked at a local law firm. I also coached the SVHS Boys Track Team. I decided to finish law school as a visiting student at USM. I still wasn't sure where I wanted to take the bar exam, so I started working as a paralegal. In 2004, my wife and I decided to move to Arizona. We had a pick-up truck, clothing, and \$7,000. We didn't have jobs or a place to stay. She took the nursing boards, and I took the bar exam. She subsequently got her masters degree and is now a nurse practitioner. I did five years at the attorney general's office where I worked as a trial lawyer, and then decided to move to a private company called TASER (later renamed Axon). We went from a small company to the world's leading public safety technology provider. Beyond TASERs, we make body cameras, drones and software. Emily Marion - What do you think are the most important qualities for achieving success?

Depends on the day you ask, but I think it would be getting comfortable with being uncomfortable. Every great thing that has happened to me, has happened by putting myself out there - feeling like I wanted to turn around and wanting to not do it. I was nervous, intimidated, feeling like I'm not good enough, others are better. I sometimes felt like an imposter. But every time I stuck with it and worked through being uncomfortable, it wasn't as bad as I thought it would be. And whether I was successful or not, I was better because of it. You will really be amazed how much you grow from those opportunities. Second to that, it is really important who you hitch your cart to. Spend time with people who make you better when you are around them. Find people that are equally as motivated as you are and have good character, and they will bring the best out in you. Sarah Cox - If you could go back in time and do something differently, what would it be?

I think it would be to really enjoy the moment and not hurry to the next thing. I have lots of fond memories of SVHS and childhood, but I was always in a hurry to grow up, to graduate. I did myself a bit of disservice. I wish I had relaxed a little and enjoyed where I was in the moment. Emily Reynolds - What are your best memories from Sacopee Valley High School?

I have great memories. I was a track athlete, and I have many great memories of afternoon practices in the spring, although maybe not the three mile runs, I enjoyed my teachers, Janet Harriman was one of my favorite teachers, I felt really fortunate about my education at SVHS. Obviously SVHS is out in the boonies a little bit, but the quality of teachers is exceptional and they really care. I have never in my life felt outmatched by anyone else. Being a lawyer is really competitive and I've competed with kids from private high schools and lawyers with Harvard Law degrees and I have always been well-prepared with my education from Sacopee Valley High School.

Dr. Carl Landry, Superintendent of Schools Thank you, Isaiah! You are at the highest level. I agree with you about the education at Sacopee Valley. We can all sometimes feel like we are imposters and we are not good enough, but I hope the students clearly heard that they can be anything they want to be coming from Sacopee Valley. We are so appreciative of you being here and your incredible generosity to MSAD 55.




He was predeceased by his parents, and his brothers Danny and Donnie.
