Dotty graduated high school at the age of 16 and went on to Gorham State Teachers College to get her degree. Her teaching career started in 1946 at the North Baldwin Rural School where she taught for two years. At the age of 21 she married the love of her life, Ernest (Joe) Hulit. They had three sons. In 1957 she went back to teaching kindergarten in the basement of the Sebago Lake Church until the class was moved to George E. Jack School where she stayed until 1977. Her last teaching position was at Steep Falls Elementary School where she taught for ten years. She retired in 1987 after teaching the last of her six grandchildren.

As a teacher, she did many fun things for the children in her class. Today many still remember the joy she had at pulling out loose teeth and putting them in the teddy bear card she made. She was also known for her letter people and teaching the children the songs of each of them as they learned the alphabet. Her classroom was always filled with love and joy.

Dotty loved having company at her house. Some of her favorite times were spent sitting around her kitchen table, reminiscing, and sharing stories. She would talk about her upbringing and growing up poor. She loved to share old photos of Steep Falls or reciting the songs and rhymes she used to teach in her kindergarten class. She also loved to play Skip-Bo. Not sure how she did it, but she would win 9 out of 10 times. Her other favorite spot in the summer was sitting on her front porch. As soon as she came out, the neighbors would all gather there with her. All you could hear was laughter. It was the best place to be on a warm summer night. She was known for her Saturday night baked beans, red hot dogs, and brown bread dinners with her family. She could never seem to keep her apron clean.

Dotty was involved in many local organizations. Her greatest interest was with the Steep Falls Baptist church. As she grew older, she was physically unable to attend the services in person. However, the Lord continued walking with her, speaking to her, and filling her home with His presence. She joined the Red Hat Society. She loved getting all dressed up in her purple dress which was her favorite color, wearing a fancy hat and spending time with her ladies.

During the last years of her life, she grew infatuated with the life cycle of the monarch butterfly. Each summer family and friends would bring her caterpillars which she would protect until they were ready to fly away as beautiful butterflies.

Dotty truly left a legacy behind her in Steep Falls. She influenced so many in her life whether through teaching, the church, speaking at events, or just spending time with her. She was a pillar of the community. She was adored and loved by everyone that met her and will be greatly missed by all those that knew her.

She is survived by her children, Ernest (Joey) Hulit and his wife, Pam of Steep Falls, Robin Hulit and his wife, Linda of Gorham, and James (Jim) Hulit and his wife, Mary Lynn of Steep Falls. Her grandchildren, Robyn (Soozy) Hulit, Jamie Hulit, Crystal Cormier, Josh Hulit, Amanda Plympton, and Luke Hulit. Her great grandchildren, Ben Hulit, Max Cormier, and Lucas Hulit. Dr. Jeffery Lynn Gilliland

HIRAM - Dr. Jeffery Lynn Gilliland died on March 24, 2024, at Maine Medical Center, Portland, Maine after suffering a sudden cardiac event at his home in Hiram, Maine.

He was born in Fresno, California on February 4, 1959, to Thomas Edsel Gilliland, an entomologist with the USDA, and Jessie Louis (Tripp) Gilliland. As a very young child Dr. Gilliland lived for two years in Tehran, Iran. His family were the guests of the Shah Mohammad Reza Pahlavi while his dad was on loan to the United States AID program through the USDA. Upon return to the United States, his family lived in Southern California, first in Merced and then Bakersfield. Dr. Gilliland's family then moved to Tallahassee, Florida where he attended elementary, middle, and high school.

During high school, and a short time after, he worked for a local Tallahassee veterinarian, Dr. Harry Taylor as well as at Live Oak Stable, an English riding stable. Both experiences ignited his passion for veterinary medicine. As God often does, He changed the direction of Dr. Gilliland's life by guiding him to enlist in the United States Marine Corps. After boot camp at the "sunny sea side resort of Parris Island, South Carolina," he was assigned to USMCAS Memphis, Tennessee as an aircraft communications/navigation electrical weapons system technician. The command saw something greater in him, thus he was offered an officer's commission through the Marine Corps Enlisted Commissioning Program. This took him to the Basic School in Quantico, VA. After the basic school he obtained an assignment as an Infantry Officer. He was assigned to MCB Barstow, "the Stumps" California. Then it was on to MCB Okinawa, Japan. While at Okinawa, he traveled widely around Asia. He returned to the US and was stationed at The Marine Corps Recruit Depot in San Diego and then MCB Camp Lejeune in Jacksonville, North Carolina. He saw combat in Kuwait and Kuwait City during the first Desert Storm. He traveled the mediterranean courtesy of the USMC and the US Navy. While on active duty, Dr. Gilliland obtained a bachelor's degree from National University in San Diego.

After leaving active USMC service, Dr. Gilliland continued his education at the University of Georgia in Athens, Georgia obtaining a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree. After college Dr. Gilliland worked at various veterinary clinics in the Northeast Georgia area. In 2014 Dr. Gilliland followed the call of the Lord and purchased the Sacopec Veterinary Clinic in Cornish, Maine of which he was still the owner and operator of at the time of his death.

Dr. Gilliland was an evangelical Christian and a firm believer of Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. He had extensive training in sharing his faith and routinely handed out bibles at the clinic in Cornish. He participated in a medical mission trip to Haiti and various trips to the Appalachian Mountain area.

In his leisure time, Dr. Gilliland enjoyed the hunting season, especially deer and turkey. He had many ancestors that fought in the American Revolutionary War and the American Civil War, on both sides, and thus enjoyed studying and learning about those times of American history. He loved to travel and would always take the road less traveled. His two favorite foreign countries were Korea and Israel. He was always willing to try new cuisines. This is how he learned the valuable lesson to not eat the bird's nest soup at the various establishment outside the Olongapo gate of the Subic Bay Naval Base in the Philippines, albeit too late.

Dr. Gilliland is survived by his wife of 35 years, Beverly Russell, Hiram, ME; his brother, Robert Gilliland (Martha) of Tallahassee, Florida; and his sisters, Nancy Short and Barbara (Tom) Harrison both of California.

He is preceded in death by his brother, Thomas Gilliland; and his parents.


She was the secretary at White Rock Elementary School in Gorham for 24 years, then later participated in the Gorham Schools' Foster Grandparent program.

To Our Customers,

The Cornish Water District (the District) will be filing a revised rate schedule with the Maine Public Utilities Commission, to be effective July 1, 2024. The filing is made under provisions of 35-A-M.R.S.A. Section 6104. The docket number for the filing is 2024-00069.

Present rates were effective January 1, 2019. Since the last rate increase, operating expenses have increased and the District is undertaking \$2,856,000 of capital improvement projects for lead service line replacements and a water main replacement on Route 25. The District is receiving over \$1 million of free money for these capital improvement projects but long-term debt will be issued for approximately \$1.8 million. In order to pay these new debt service obligations and continue properly maintaining its water system, the District is proposing an overall revenue increase of \$108,534 as shown below:

Residential	\$ 50,589	53%
Commercial	\$ 19,817	53%
Public Authorities	\$ 2,003	53%
Public Fire Protection	\$ 34,000	60%
Private Fire Protection	\$ 655	53%
Other Revenues	\$ 1,470	53%
	<u>\$108,534</u>	55%

The public fire protection increase is governed by Public Utilities Commission Chapter 69. In accordance with Chapter 69, the public fire protection revenue is set at 30% of total operating revenue.

A **Public Hearing** will be held on **Monday, April 29, 2024 at 5:00 p.m.**
at the **Water District Office** located at **3 Pavilion Road**
at which time complete details will be furnished in support of the increase.

You may inspect data relating to the present and proposed rates at the District before the hearing. 

To the Selectmen of Brownfield, Maine

I, Vincent Lanovara, a resident of the Town of Brownfield, Maine, am making a formal request for the following "Debarment Ordinance" to be included in the Selectmen's Warrant for the Town of Brownfield, Maine Annual Town Meeting in June of 2024 to see if the Town will vote and enact the following debarment ordinance.

A debarment ordinance provides that:

- The opportunity to bid on Town contracts, supply goods or services to the Town or apply for a permanent license is a privilege and not a right.
- The privilege of transacting business with or applying for a permit or license from the Town should be denied to persons or companies involved in contract crime.
- The privilege of transacting business with or applying for a permit of license from the Town should also be denied to an affiliate or subsidiary of a convicted company.
- No person or business entity shall be awarded a contract, permit, or license if that person or business entity has been convicted of bribery or attempting to bribe a public officer or employee of the Town or any other public entity.
- Has been convicted of an agreement of collusion among bidders or prospective bidders, in restraint of freedom of competition, to bid a fixed price.
- Has been convicted of violations of environmental laws or other laws that reflect the ability of the applicant or permittee to operate in a satisfactory manner.
- Has made an admission of guilt of such conduct described above, which is a matter of record, but has not been prosecuted for such conduct.

A person, business entity, officer, or employee of a business entity, convicted of one or more of the crimes described above shall be ineligible for a contract, subcontract, permit, license for a period of three years.

To the Selectmen of Brownfield, Maine

I, Vincent Lanovara, a resident of the Town of Brownfield, Maine, am making a formal request for the following to be included for a definitive and procedural requirement for an "official" formal committee on the selectmen's warrant for the Town of Brownfield Annual Town Meeting in June of 2024 to see if the town will vote to enact the following ordinance.

The intent of this ordinance is not to prevent the establishment of any committee but to ensure uniformity and accountability.

An official formal town committee must:

- State its **purpose** and effect on the Town of Brownfield and its citizens.
- Have an established **structure**. This requires a definitive number of members, their length of term and expiration dates, an internally elected board; a chairman to facilitate meetings, a vice chairman to assist during meetings or act as chairman when necessary; and a secretary to record and file all actions and events at meetings. Also, a treasurer may be elected for the recording of any appropriated revenues, monies, and their expenditures. The treasurer's position may be combined with any of the previously mentioned board members.
- Be **accountable** to the Town of Brownfield and its citizens by the process of election at the annual town voting or any special town meeting for that purpose. When a vacancy occurs prior to the termination of a member's term, the selectmen will make an appointment.


There have been many repairs made over the


