Louis Everett Saucier Sr.

PORTER - Louis Everett Saucier Sr., age, 82, passed

away peacefully on June 6, 2025. He was the oldest child, and only son of Romanio Saucier of Fort Kent and Alberta Fox Saucier of Porter. He was born on March 2, 1943 in Hiram and has lived his entire life in Porter. He graduated from Porter High School in 1962. Everyone who knew him called him Louie.

Louie was a very hard worker. As a youngster he mowed lawns and washed windows. He was tall and looked mature for his age. At fourteen years old he worked in the woods

logging with the Roberts Brothers (claiming he was sixteen). Then, he worked at Churchill Motors detailing cars. It was there he bought some great cars - like a beautiful 1959 Buick Convertible, white with blue leather interior and a black top. He always had money in his pocket and gave much of it to his mother to hold for him. He worked at Aetna, Masonry Building Construction in NH, the Box Shop and the Woolen Mill, as a weaver on piece-work. By 1972 he returned to Aetna where he remained until retirement. Aetna became ITT and then Vulcan Electric. He became a floor leader and developed a great passion for cost reductions, creating tools, solving problems and designing products. If he was told something couldn't be done, and he believed it could - he proved it, time and time again. He was the creator of many firsts in the heating element industry. He attributed his accomplishments to common sense and keeping things simple. He was a self-made engineer and loved the research and development of new products and improving old ones. He worked at Vulcan Electric for 33 years, retiring in 2005. However, he continued working as a consultant.

In 1969, he married Elayne Mota-Nickerson (currently of Madawaska Maliseet First Nation, NB, Canada) and became an instant father of her four young boys. In 1971, Louis Jr. was born. He loved his family and worked up to sixty hours a week providing for them. During the October/November trapping season he would tend traps at nights and on weekends. He sold fox, coon, otter, muskrat and fisher cat pelts and put the money toward Christmas for his five boys. He also enjoyed being a Pop to three foreign exchange students while the boys were in high school; Kokan from Yugoslavia and Marcelo and Fab (Fabrico) from Brazil.

He always had a great vegetable garden and canned whatever he harvested. For years, he picked up to sixty pounds of fiddleheads each spring and enjoyed growing potatoes for the winter. He liked to cook and made a great curried chicken, spaghetti sauce and perfectly seasoned steak.

In 1992 he married Laurie Elaine Brunk. They built a wonderful life and did everything together. The most



important thing to Louie was his family. He loved mak-

ing the homestead he built, a place his family could always come to and make fun memories. Louie was kind hearted and would help anyone and often loaned people money. He was a man of routine, starting each day with instant coffee, two toast with nearly a half stick of butter and a newspaper. He loved a good cold beer and a very slow ride around Bickford Pond every single day.

Louie loved the outdoors; hunting, trapping, fishing, boating and gardening. In earlier years, he had a coon dog and rabbit dog.

He enjoyed duck, partridge and turkey hunting. His greatest passion was deer hunting and climbing mountains. As a toddler, he went hunting with his mother. He was given his first gun at eight years old and by the age of ten was hiking over the mountain to his grandmother's house in Kezar Falls Village, by himself. He shot his first deer when he was eleven, a 215 pound - 10 point buck. During his lifetime he shot over one hundred deer and boasted an impressive 20-plus bucks weighing 200 – 245 pounds. He also loved bear hunting - on equal terms - with no bait and no dogs - and shot 13. In 2004, he designed and created the Saucier's L.S.Game Drag, a specialty drag rope with pocket-size handles for dragging deer and bear out of the woods.

He is predeceased by his stepson, William "Billy" M. Nickerson; and his dear nephew, Dean Murray, who was the greatest inspiration in his life.

Louis is survived by his loving wife of nearly 33 years and best friend, Laurie Brunk Saucier, and their dog, Gabbie; his first wife and friend, Elayne Nickerson-Saucier of NB, Canada; two sisters, LaVerne Fox Saucier and Mike of Porter, Carol Saucier and Mike of Limington; one son, Louis (Butch) Saucier Jr. of Porter; three step-sons, Wayne Nickerson and Karen of Bangor; Mike Nickerson and Sue of Albany, NH, David Nickerson and Teri of Gorham; grandchildren, Zach Curtis of FL, and Nick Saucier and fiance, Brooke of Parsonsfield; step-grandchildren, Ariel, Brandon, Callie, Bailey, Logan, Tristan; nine step-great grandchildren; and nephews and nieces, Jeremy, Jessica, Tamara, Jon, Jace and Jessie.



MAINE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION TO FILE NOTICE OF INTENT UNDER GENERAL PERMIT FOR APPLICATION OF AQUATIC HERBICIDES FOR THE CONTROL OF INVASIVE AQUATIC PLANTS

The Maine Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Environmental Assessment's Invasive Aquatic Species Program (IASP), intends to file a Notice of Intent (NOI) with the Maine Department of Environmental Protection Division of Water Quality Management for herbicide treatment of a portion of Sokokis Pond (AKA Holland Pond) in Limerick, ME to control the invasive aquatic plant brittle naiad (Najas minor). The application is for a permit to discharge the aquatic herbicide Aquastrike (active ingredients dipotassium salt of endothall and diquat dibromide) via subsurface injection through perforated hose from a surface watercraft.

The herbicide will be applied to portions of Sokokis where this invasive plant is found. The treatment will likely occur mid-to-late July 2025. Since the plant appears to be in an early stage of establishment, the treatment goal is to prevent its spread in Sokokis and to other waters by eradicating this plant population. If eradication is not possible, the objective is to significantly diminish the brittle naiad in Sokokis to reduce risk of spread and allow future management with non-chemical control methods. The treatment is part of a five-year management plan.

The IASP will hold an in-person public information meeting regarding the proposed herbicide treatment Monday, June 16, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. at the Limerick Municipal Center, 55 Washington Street, Limerick, ME.

Upon treatment, the IASP will post these advisories for the area treated:

- Do not drink lake water for 3 days after treatment
- Do not allow livestock to consume lake water for 1 day after treatment
- Do not irrigate turf and landscape ornamentals for 3 days after treatment
- Do not irrigate food crops for 5 days after treatment
- There is no swimming restriction for Aquastrike but the IASP advises residents not to swim within treated areas on the day of treatment as an added safety measure.

This letter is to inform potentially interested parties of land being acquired by Limerick Water District (LWD). The Water District has applied for a low interest loan through the Maine Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) administered by the Maine Drinking Water Program (DWP) to purchase land and/or conservation easements that will play a role in protecting the District's water source of supply.

Since the DWSRF is using Federal funds to provide loans to public water systems, there are necessary requirements. One requirement for this loan, and the reason for this letter, is that an environmental review must be completed. The Maine DWP has reviewed the project and issued a categorical exclusion, meaning a full environmental review is not needed for this land and/or conservation easement purchase because there are no plans to develop the property. The categorical exclusion does require informing interested parties, such as property abutters, about the ownership change for the property in question, and allowing them a chance to submit comments or concerns to the DWP. As required by Section 6 of the State of Maine Rules Relating to Drinking Water, State Revolving Loan Fund, Chapter 230, the Department of Health and Human Services, Drinking Water Program (DWP) staff prepared a "Justification for Categorical Exclusion" on behalf of Limerick Water District to exempt a proposed action from formal environmental review requirements.

The proposed action is to purchase a parcel of land comprised of 45.5 acres in Limerick, Maine. As development and human activities have the potential to contaminate public water supply sources, the DWP considers land ownership the most desirable means of protection. The DWP has determined that the full parcel is within Limerick Water District's wellhead protection area located near the intersection of Emery Corner Road and Quarry Road in Limerick, as delineated by Dirigo Engineering in their "New Well Approval Report for Limerick Water District Auxiliary Well for the Limerick Water District, July 13, 2021.

BALD LEDGE: Q

Views of Colcord Pond and surrounding hills. There are two trails to the summit. Neither trailhead parking lot is plowed in winter. From the junction of Old County Rd and ME 25/160 in Porter, drive north to Colcord Pond Rd. - Varney Rd Trailhead: After 2.8 miles, where Colcord Pond Rd bears right, follow Dana Weeks Rd, then Kennard Hill Rd. Drive 1.5 miles and turn right on Danforth Rd. At the split, bear right on Varney Rd. The trail is 1.4 miles long, round trip. Easy.

 Colcord Pond Rd Trailhead: Continue on Colcord Pond Rd for about 0.5 miles - the parking lot is on the left. The trail is about 2 miles long, round trip. Moderate difficulty.

Views of Colcord Pond and surrounding hills. From ME 160 turn west on to Porterfield Rd. In 1.4 miles, turn left onto Norton Hill Rd. In 1.4 miles, go straight onto Moody Rd. Parking lot and trailhead is almost 0.5 miles further, on the left. The trail is 1 mile long, round trip. Relatively easy. For more information visit https://fsht.org

An easy walk along the shore of Ingalls Pond as well as the Saco River. Follow ME 113 to West Baldwin and continue north of village about 2 miles. Ingalls Pond is directly across from Estes Quarry.

Views of the Saco River and a waterfall. Located in Limington, 0.5 miles west of the junction of ME 25 and ME 117 at Olives Way. A sign at Olives Way marks the right of way to the preserve. The trail is a loop about ½ mile long. Easy.

RIVERVIEW FAMILY TRAILS: Q

The old county road is a flat walking trail. Snowmobiles and ATVs are allowed in season. Stairs lead to a walking trail less than 1/4 mile long from the old road along the river. This property is adjacent to a canoe launch maintained by F&W. From Cornish Center, follow Rt 5 N / Rt 117 N toward Baldwin for 1 mile. Riverview is on the right, just before the bridge. From Rt 113 in Baldwin, take Rt 5 S / Rt 117 S and turn left after the bridge. Easy.

SAWYER MOUNTAIN HIGHLANDS:

There is access from 2 sides of the mountain with views of Sebago Lake and Ossipee Mountain from the top.

• The **Sherwood Libby** trailhead is located on ME 117, 2.5 miles south of ME 25 in Limington. Trail is 4.6 miles long, round trip. Moderate difficulty.

- The Nature Trail located near Sherwood Libby trail is a ¾ mile long walk where nine stations feature points of educational interest. Easy.
- The Smith Trail is located on Sawyer Mountain Road in Limerick, 0.9-mile past Libby's U-Pick. Trail is 2.6 miles long, round trip. Moderate difficulty.

SISSON EASEMENT/ THE HEATH:

The trail is a 3 mile long walk through woods around the Heath, a wetland. Easy. From Limerick on ME 5, 3 miles north of ME 5/160, past the metal guard rail, turn right between the guard rail and a huge rock. From Cornish on ME 5, 5.7 miles south of ME 5/25; turn left immediately after road curves around a huge rocky outcrop. (0.4-0.5 miles from Spur Rd. after Beldan Dr. on left).
