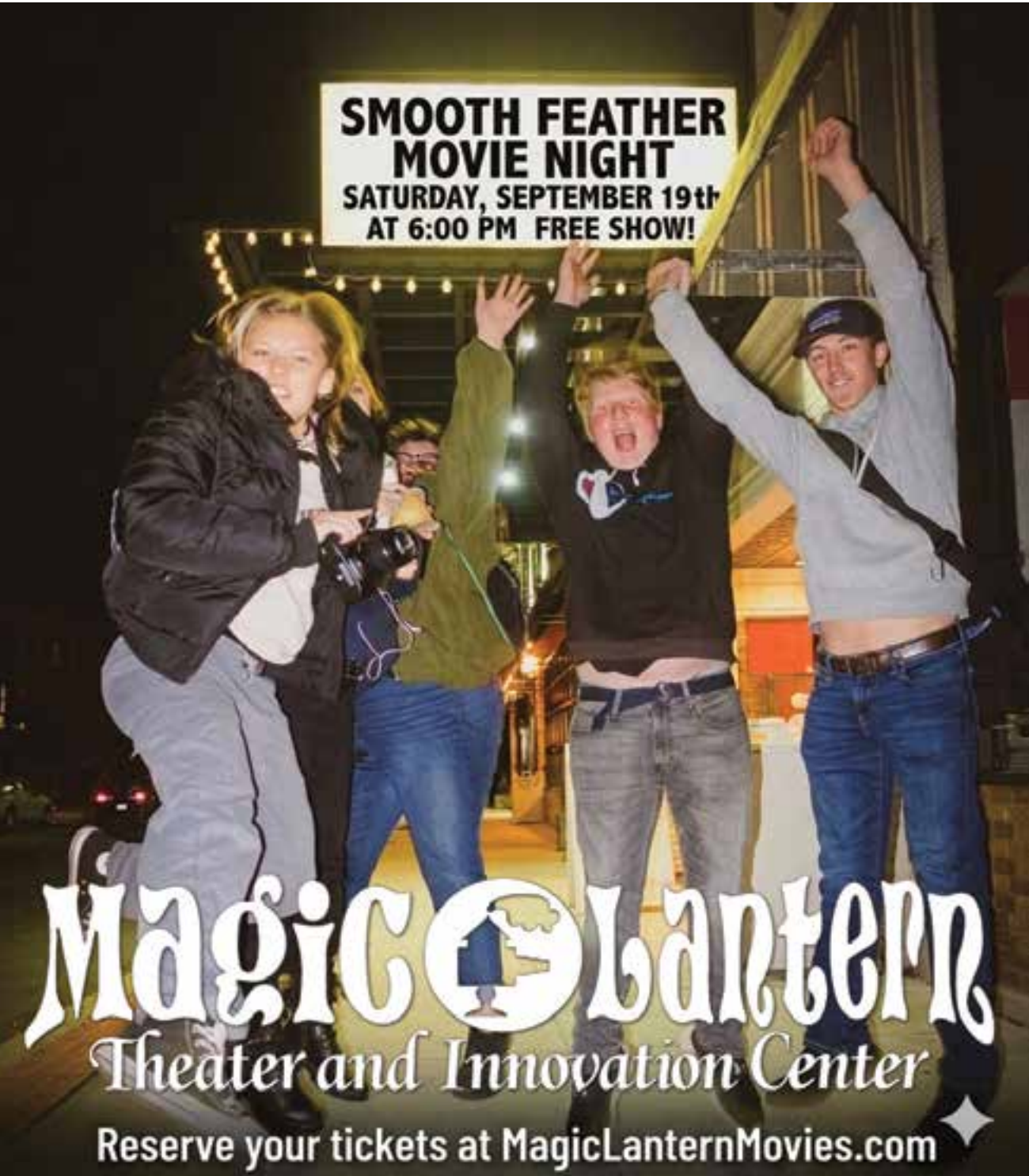

Creetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Standish, in the County of Cumberland, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Standish Municipal Center, 175 Northeast Road in Standish, on **TUESDAY**, the 3rd day of November 2026, at 6:30 in the forenoon, to act on Article 1 and by secret ballot on Articles 2-4, as follows:

Art. 1. To elect a moderator by written ballot to preside at said meeting.

Art. 2. Shall the municipality approve the charter amendment summarized below, to take effect immediately upon adoption?

Summary of Amendment: This proposed charter amendment reduces the number of meetings necessary for the Town Council to adopt an ordinance from three to two. The proposed ordinance would be introduced at the first meeting, with a public hearing and potential action on the proposed ordinance to take place at a subsequent meeting held at least seven (7) days after notice is given. Once adopted, ordinances would be published on the Town’s website but would not be published in the newspaper. The complete text of the proposed amendments is on file at the office of the Town Clerk.

Art. 3. Shall the municipality approve the charter amendments summarized below, to take effect immediately upon adoption?

Summary of Amendments: These proposed charter amendments increase the total cost of capital expenditures requiring submission to and approval by referendum vote from \$75,000 to \$150,000. The complete text of the proposed amendments is on file at the office of the Town Clerk.

Art. 4. Shall an ordinance entitled “Mobile Home Park Lot Rent Stabilization” be enacted?

(An attested true copy of the full text of this ordinance has been posted together with this warrant, and copies are available at the Town Clerk’s office and will be available at the polls.)

The Polls open at 7:00 am and close at 8:00 pm.

The Registrar of Voters will hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any error or change a name or address on the voting list; to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote; and to accept new enrollments.

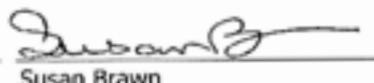

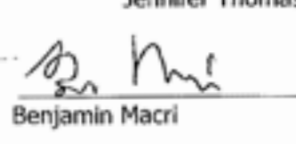

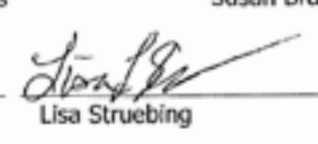

Debbie purchased her dream home in Porter, Maine 25 years ago with her husband Scott. She worked for many years as the Wellness Director of the Portland YMCA before retiring in 2016. She enjoyed being a part of the local community – regularly attending church at Riverside United Methodist, volunteering at the clothing barn, baking treats for fundraisers, and supporting local artisans and community events. She loved her property – listening to the birds, tending to her gardens, catching glimpses of wildlife, and watching the sun set over the mountains. She loved being outside – even during blackfly season – and excitedly waited every year for the snow... but only because one of her favorite activities was shoveling. She got many double-takes when she was seen cruising around on her Harley – all 95lbs of her – and proudly sported her "GRTKIDS" license plate on every Subaru she ever owned.

Debbie filled her home with love – and it was loved equally in return by Brady, Mason, Madison, and Maci. From baking and soaking in the hot tub, to zip-lining, building fires, and catching frogs; snowmen, fishing, kayaking, swimming at the pond, and sleeping in the tree-house (yes, even Grammy!) – these kids knew what unconditional love felt like when they were at Grammy's



house, and they spent every moment they could with her. Grammy never missed a milestone – from all the firsts to all the lasts and everything in between; football games, piano concerts, dance competitions, softball, baseball, and lacrosse, chorus concerts, school events, or simply just driving the kids to activities, she was there for it ALL – and the memories they made with Grammy will be forever treasured.

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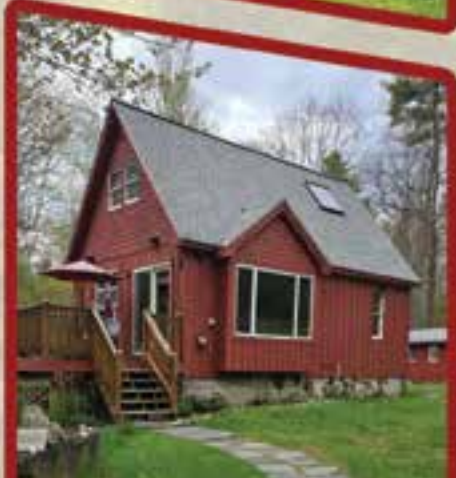
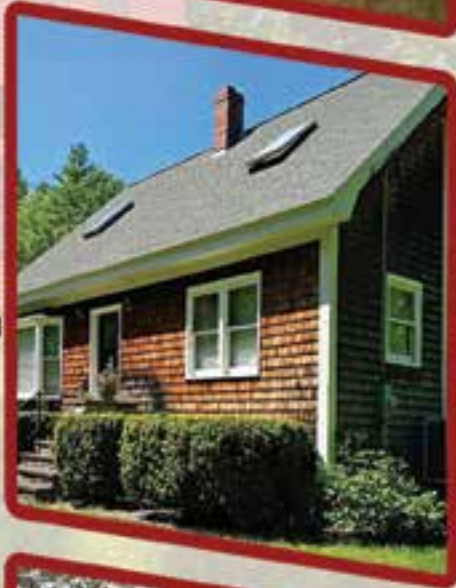
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Randi's search for a living kidney donor...

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Dear Friends & Family,

Some of you may know that I have kidney disease. I am a 76-year old from Parsonsfield, and over time, my kidney disease has gotten worse, causing my kidneys not to work well enough to keep me alive. My treatment options at this time are limited to dialysis or a kidney transplant. I have been on dialysis for some time now, 3 days a week for 4 hours each day, which is helping my kidneys do their job of removing wastes, toxins, and extra fluids. But the longer you are on dialysis the more your health deteriorates.

However, a living donor kidney transplant would offer me much more freedom and the ability to live a longer, healthier, and more meaningful life. A transplant would also give me more time to do the things I love most, such as spending time with my family and friends, my partner Nick, my pets, helping others, and being outdoors.

Finding a kidney is not easy. People who are on a wait list for a kidney from a deceased donor often have to wait 5-10 years and the kidney lasts on average 10-20 years. But the wait list for a living kidney donor is much shorter, sometimes even months, and the kidney typically lasts 20-30 years. It also has much better function.

In order to donate, living kidney donors get a careful and thorough evaluation with your own team of health professionals to see if you could be a match for me and to ensure that living donation is as safe as possible for you.

I want to share with you some basic information about kidney donation.

- 1) You only need one kidney to live a long, healthy life.
- 2) The surgery for a donor is done laparoscopically, meaning through tiny incisions, and the recuperation period is fairly quick, generally only a few of weeks.
- 3) The cost of an evaluation and surgery would be covered by my insurance, and there are programs like Donor Shield that can help with other charges.
- 4) Although my blood type is O+, you do not necessarily have to have the same blood or tissue type to be a match.
- 5) There is no age limit to be a donor. You just have to have a healthy kidney.
