Bands in his younger days included Sugar Creek, American Standard, Ruckus, American Pie, Amarillo, and The Knuckleheads. The recent band he enjoyed for years, Lil' Ken and the Blues Dawgs, truly defined his talents. He absolutely loved having the band guys over to his home for weekly jams and to play for special parties and occasions.

Kenny is predeceased by both parents, and his older brother Charles, Jr. Kenny leaves behind his daughter Jessica Day Brinkley, husband Jamie and grandson Grayson. Son, Jon Day and grandson Finley. Sister-in-law Marlene Day, niece Shauna and nephew Chaz and a grandniece and nephew. Kenny leaves behind his beloved wife Diane Nicholson, stepdaughter Helena Nicholson, granddaughter Trinity, mother-in-law Helen Nicholson and sister-in-law Lorraine Nicholson. - A post titled "Showing The New Guy That Broke Mailboxes Are Just Part Of The Job" with a video of a mailbox.
- A post by Cliff Cousins: "Cindy and I are signing autographs if anyone is interested we made the weekly shopping guide".
- A post by Cynthia L. Eaton: "Tracie Antolin huh what are talking about, I use my name Cynthia Eaton have no idea what you are accusing me of. Be careful anything I post is under my name, so be real careful of what you accusing me of doing! I have 2 Facebook accounts my fun one and my everyday one both under my name. So you causing more drama with a town employee. STOP BEFORE YOU REGRET!".
- A post by Cliff Cousins: "You selling the car you stole from the town I'll buy it from you".

The conduct displayed by certain individuals in positions of authority is troubling and is having a detrimental effect on our town. It is clear that there is a lack of accountability and responsibility among some of our officials, a situation that cannot be tolerated. As residents of Brownfield, it is imperative that we hold our leaders to the highest standards and insist on transparency and professionalism in all their dealings.

I strongly encourage you to consider lending your support to the recall petition as a means to address these pressing issues and to facilitate the restoration of trust and accountability within our municipality. By working together, we can strive towards creating a more cohesive and respectful community that benefits all residents of Brownfield.

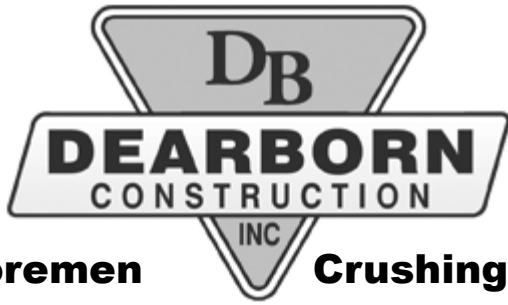

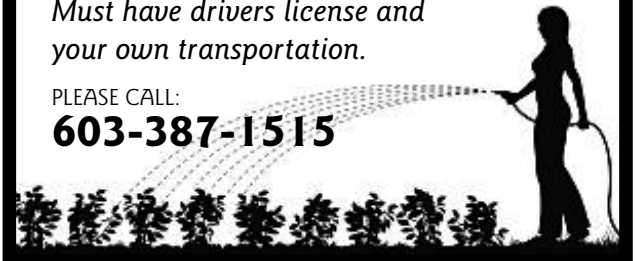

Maine Legislature Honors Six-Decade Educator ~ Walter Ridlon

AUGUSTA — The halls of the Maine State House paused on March 17th to honor a man whose career has become synonymous with Maine’s educational and athletic history. State Representative Nathan Wadsworth formally welcomed Walter Ridlon to the chamber, recognizing his years of service as a teacher, coach, and administrator.

"We often talk in this chamber about the 'long-term impact' of our policies," Wadsworth told his colleagues. "But if you want to see what long-term impact looks like in human form, you look at Walter Ridlon."

Ridlon’s career is a roadmap of Maine’s academic and sporting landscapes. A storied athlete in his own right, Ridlon was a championship winner at Gorham High and an MVP at Gorham State. His coaching career reached a pinnacle in 1974 when he was named the Maine Basketball Coach of the Year, eventually earning him a spot in the Gorham High School Sports Hall of Fame.

In 2020, the University of Southern Maine further recognized his dedication by awarding him the Richard A. "Doc" Costello Special Achievement Award, an honor reserved for alumni who show extraordinary commitment to student-athletes.

Rep. Wadsworth’s tribute took a personal turn as he reflected on Ridlon’s tenure as Principal at Sacopee Valley, where he served as Wadsworth’s own principal. Ridlon also held roles as a teacher at Mt. View and most recently serves as the Student Services Coordinator at Lake Region Vocational Center.

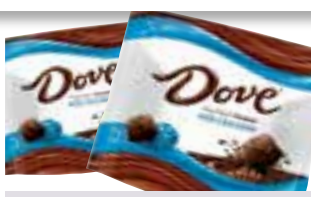

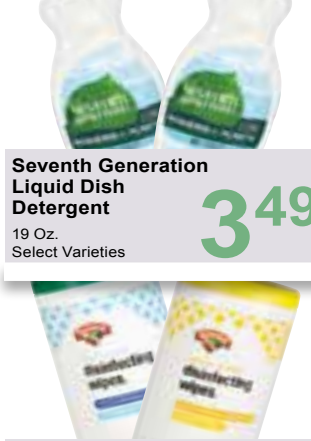

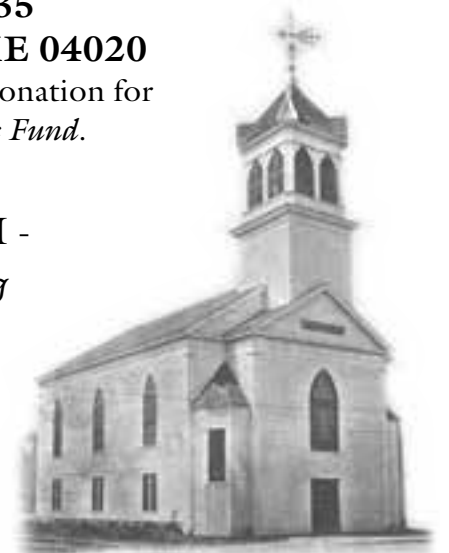
We know this will not be easy.

Randi's search for a living kidney donor...

Please consider a Gift of Life.

Dear Friends & Family,

Some of you may know that I have kidney disease. I am a 76 year old from Parsonsfield, and over time, my kidney disease has gotten worse, causing my kidneys not to work well enough to keep me alive. My treatment options at this time are limited to dialysis or a kidney transplant. I have been on dialysis for some time now, 3 days a week for 4 hours each day, which is helping my kidneys do their job of removing wastes, toxins, and extra fluids. But the longer you are on dialysis the more your health deteriorates.

However, a living donor kidney transplant would offer me much more freedom and the ability to live a longer, healthier, and more meaningful life. A transplant would also give me more time to do the things I love most, such as spending time with my family and friends, my partner Nick, my pets, helping others, and being outdoors.

Finding a kidney is not easy. People who are on a wait list for a kidney from a deceased donor often have to wait 5-10 years and the kidney lasts on average 10-20 years. But the wait list for a living kidney donor is much shorter, sometimes even months, and the kidney typically lasts 20-30 years. It also has much better function.

In order to donate, living kidney donors get a careful and thorough evaluation with your own team of health professionals to see if you could be a match for me and to ensure that living donation is as safe as possible for you.

I want to share with you some basic information about kidney donation.

- 1) You only need one kidney to live a long, healthy life.
- 2) The surgery for a donor is done laparoscopically, meaning through tiny incisions, and the recuperation period is fairly quick, generally only a few weeks.
- 3) The cost of an evaluation and surgery would be covered by my insurance, and there are programs like Donor Shield that can help with other charges.
- 4) Although my blood type is O+, you do not necessarily have to have the same blood or tissue type to be a match.
- 5) There is no age limit to be a donor. You just have to have a healthy kidney.

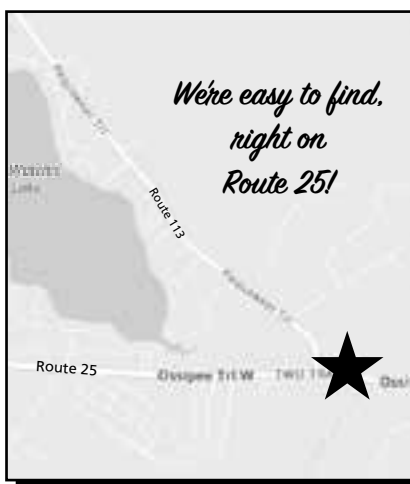
