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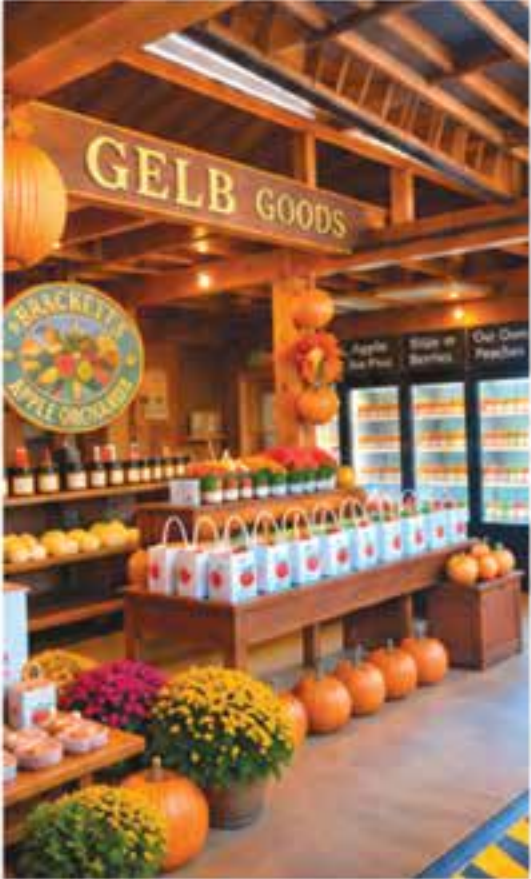

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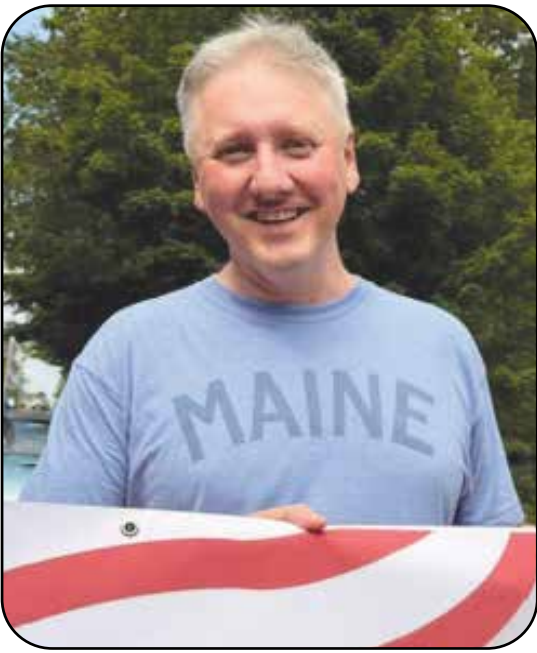

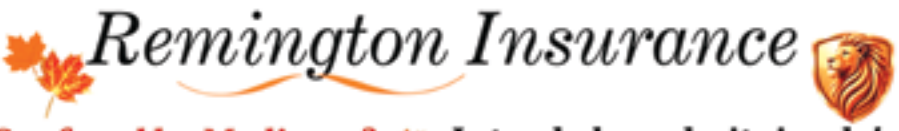

SUSAN COLLINS HAS WON THE BILLIONAIRE VOTE IN A LANDSLIDE.

Over one hundred of them donated. She knows that she can win elections only if rich out-of- staters supply 90 percent of her campaign dollars. Why do billionaires love Collins so much that every six years they pay for her to win? It goes back to 2017 when Congress passed Trump’s giant tax cut for the rich.

Collins at first opposed the cut. Concerned the powerful private equity industry would get too many tax breaks, she announced she would break a tie vote in the Senate by voting against the cut. But following a secret meeting with industry chief Steve Schwartzman, she voted for Trump’s bill instead.

Billionaires use Collins to reach their goal of owning and running America. Another Senate win for her will hasten the day when billionaires exploit us like Bezos already exploits hundreds of thousands of Amazon Fulfillment Center employees who are sweated to the point that most last barely a year before injury or exhaustion drives them out. At his confirmation hearings for the Supreme Court, Brett Kavanaugh promised Collins he would uphold Roe v Wade as settled law. He lied. He lied again by claiming he never sexually assaulted a fellow high school student who, despite right-wing hatred and death threats, clearly and consistantly reported he had. Collins refused to believe her. Two University students disclosed he had also sexually assaulted them, but they were given no chance to testify. For a twenty-first century Republican, obedience to Party hierarchy, right or wrong, comes first.

Twice, Collins broke tie votes. She destroyed most reproductive rights for women. She passed a tax cut for the rich, creating more billionaires who filled Republican campaign war chests and worsened inequality in America.

Collins gets along well with Trump and votes for his agenda 96 percent of the time. Collins has also voted for every war in her 30 years as a Senator despite solid evidence in advance that we would lose them. She failed to recognize that Trump’s impulsive, unsound mind would lead to disaster in Iran. She also collects millions in campaign money from a foreign government, Israel, and votes yearly to supply arms for its endless wars.

Let’s decide it’s time for Susan Collins to retire. She’s done enough harm.
